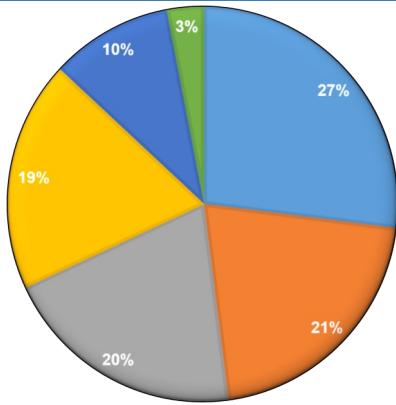


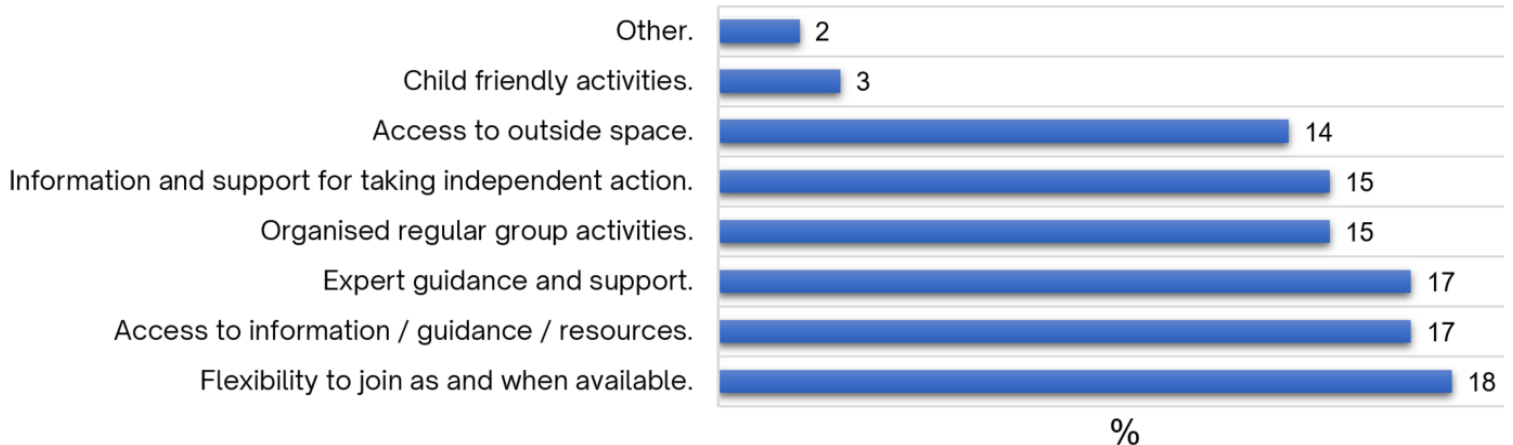
Key themes



What activities would you like to do?

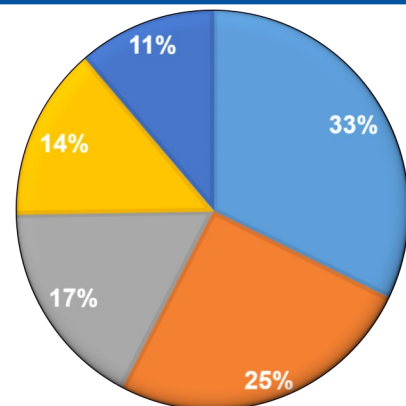
- * 27% - Practical conservation activities.
